



Rules and Regulations for Dennis Conservation Land Trust Conservation Properties

The following rules and regulations have been designed for all fee-simple lands owned by Dennis Conservation Land Trust (DCLT), and will be reviewed and revised as needed by the DCLT Land Committee. In the event that these rules and regulations are violated and require response, please refer to the Land Stewardship Violation Guidelines.

The following acts and uses are prohibited on, above, and below all lands owned by the Dennis Conservation Land Trust, described here as “the Premises”:

1. Making or kindling a campfire or other fire for personal use of any kind, except as required for DCLT-sanctioned land management purposes;
2. Camping on the Premises during the day or overnight, except by written permission;
3. Hunting and trapping;
4. Cutting, removing, or otherwise destroying trees, grasses, or other vegetation, except as required for DCLT-sanctioned land management purposes;
5. The disruption, defacing, removal, or destruction of any signs or structures;
6. Placing, filling, storing or dumping on the Premises of soil, refuse, trash, yard waste, vehicle bodies or parts, debris, or other material whatsoever;
7. Damming, filling or discharging into water resources;
8. Mining, excavating, dredging or removing from the Premises of soil, loam, peat, gravel, sand, rock or other mineral resource or natural deposit or to otherwise make topographical changes to an area;
9. No snowmobiles, motorcycles, mopeds, all-terrain vehicles, bicycles, trail bikes, or any other motorized or non-motorized vehicles of any kind shall be used, parked, stored, maintained, operated or otherwise allowed on the Premises, except for vehicles necessary for public safety (i.e. fire, police, ambulance, other government officials) in carrying out their lawful duties, or by DCLT or its agents as required for land management purposes;

Constructing, placing or allowing to remain any temporary or permanent building, tennis court, landing strip, mobile home, swimming pool, asphalt or concrete pavement, sign, fence, billboard or other advertising display, antenna, utility pole, tower, conduit, line or other temporary or permanent structure or facility on, above or under the Premises;
11. Activities detrimental to drainage, flood control, water conservation, water quality, erosion control, soil conservation or archaeological conservation;
12. Distributing, posting, placing or erecting any bills, notices, papers or advertising device or matter of any kind except by written authorization of the Dennis Conservation Land Trust;
13. To sell or offer for sale, any merchandise, article or service;
14. Any Criminal Acts as defined by Massachusetts General Laws.
