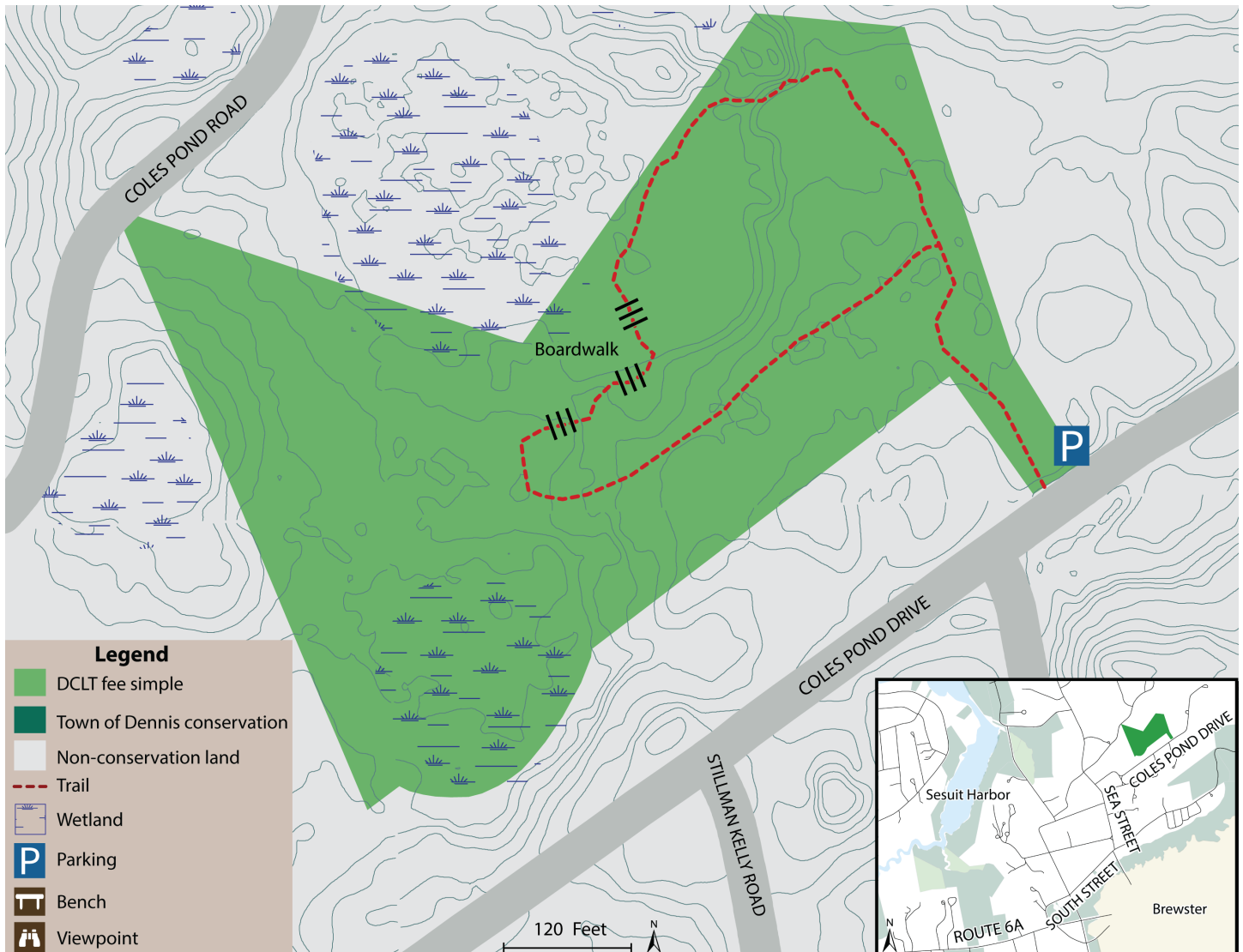




Coles Pond Bog

Enjoy the trails and keep in mind:

- ◆ No fires, camping, or vehicles
- ◆ No smoking or alcohol
- ◆ Carry out what you carry in
- ◆ Respect private property
- ◆ Do not disturb or remove plants or wildlife
- ◆ No hunting



The Coles Pond Bog trailhead starts in a neighborhood and takes you back into a well-loved trail lined with oaks and shrubs. Continue to the bog, where volunteers and staff have laid an extensive boardwalk to allow access through this habitat, which floods during certain times of the year. As you leave the bog, you'll pass a stonewall, a marker separating one field from another in the area's agricultural past. Throughout this coastal area, listen for cardinals and other signs of wildlife.

Trail: Easy, sections of boardwalk, 0.35 miles.

Directions: 82 Coles Pond Drive, East Dennis; travel east 0.7 miles from the intersection of Rt. 134 and Rt. 6A before turning left on South St. Take another left on Sea St, and then a right on Coles Pond Dr. Watch for the trailhead and DCLT sign on the left, with space for parking in front of the trailhead on the side of the road.
