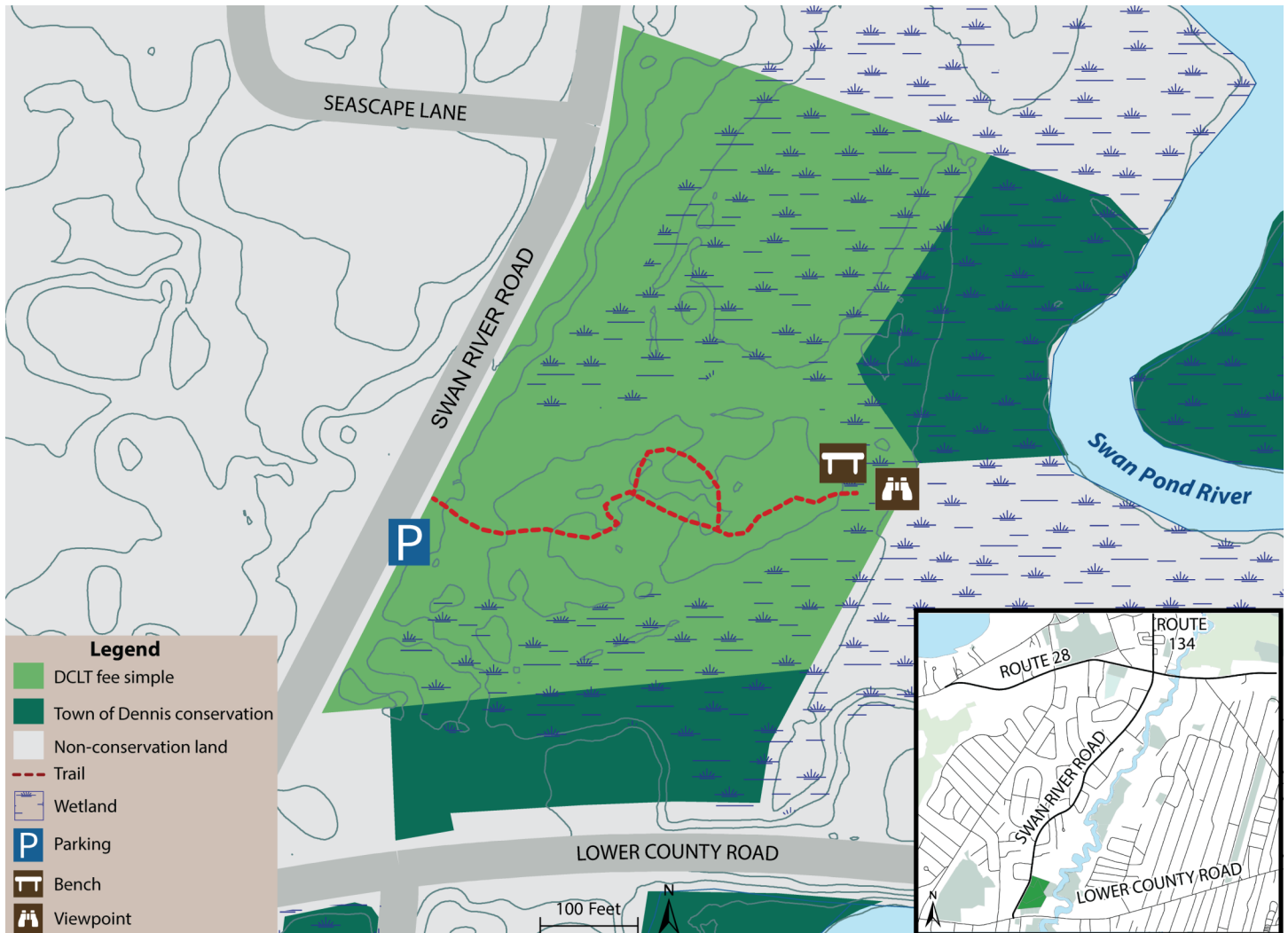




Swan River Outlook

Enjoy the trails and keep in mind:

- ◆ No fires, camping, or vehicles
- ◆ No smoking or alcohol
- ◆ Carry out what you carry in
- ◆ Respect private property
- ◆ Do not disturb or remove plants or wildlife
- ◆ No hunting



Looking for inkberry? As you wander along the path towards Swan River, take the opportunity to appreciate the many inkberry shrubs that line the path. Tall pitch pines, oaks, holly, and bayberry can be found along the trail, as well as grasses and wildflowers. At the end of the path, sit on the bench overlooking the tidal river and enjoy an afternoon watching the wildlife, sketching, or reading.

Trail: Easy and flat, 0.11 miles.

Directions: 24 Swan River Rd, West Dennis; head south on Swan River Rd from the intersection of Rt. 134-Rt. 28, and the trailhead and DCLT sign will be on the left with ample space to park along the road.
