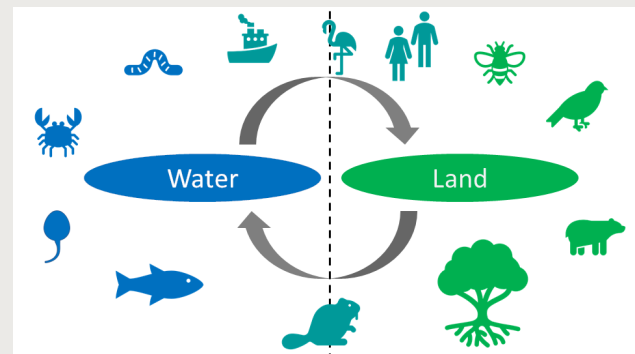

Did you know...



It's bloomin' again, already? Skunk cabbage (*Symplocarpus foetidus*), sometimes called the first flower of spring, is a stinky, low-growing perennial found in swamps and wetlands. It can grow and bloom through ice and snow thanks to a special characteristic more common among birds and mammals - the ability to generate heat. Once the flower matures, pollinators are lured with its special, skunky odor.
