Stewardship day with the NLC



Last week DCLT volunteers carpooled off Cape to remove invasive plants from the Native Land Conservancy's (NLC's) 'Wampanoag Common Lands' property.

This joint stewardship day represents the ongoing collaborative partnership between the DCLT and NLC.

This past December the organizations signed a 'Cultural Respect Easement' to provide and encourage access to DCLT properties for Indigenous cultural practices.
