Did you know...



American chestnuts were once a dominant tree in Eastern forests from the Gulf Coast

north to Maine. In the late 1800s an invasive fungus - chestnut blight - killed 3+ billion trees, taking the rich nutty food source along with it. Today American chestnuts are virtually extinct, though efforts to genetically modify them for resistance to chestnut blight are well underway.
