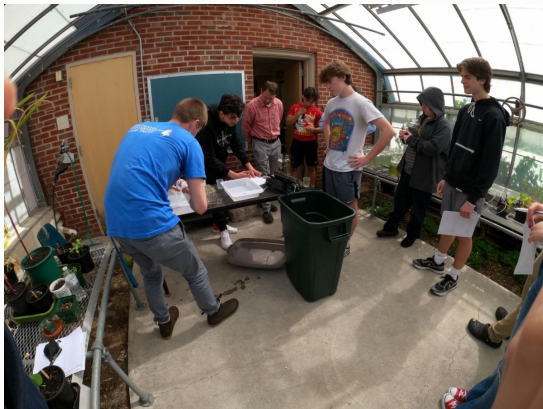

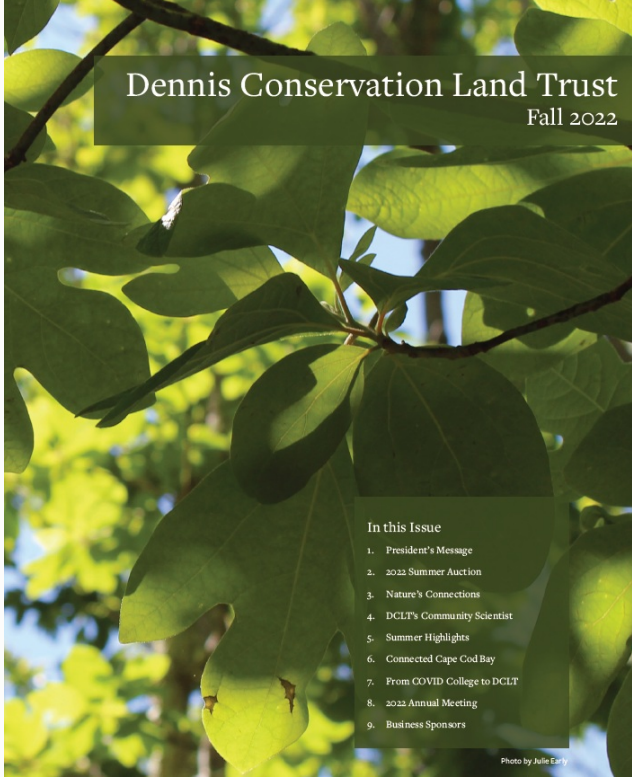
#### Read DCLT's Fall Newsletter!
