To Whom It May Concern:

On December 1, 2025 the Dennis Conservation Land Trust (DCLT) attended the monthly meeting of the Advisory Committee on Disabilities (ACD) and provided an overview of their plan to purchase a 12.5 acre parcel of land in Dennis Port. This property is adjacent to the Town owned Plashes Conservation Area. Combined, the two properties would provide a 61 acre network of conservation land for trails and public access. It would give Dennis Port, an area designated as a low-income “Environmental Justice Community” a protected green space allowing Dennis Port residents the opportunity for greater access to nature and outdoor exploration space for children and families.

The ACD is particularly enthusiastic about this project as it plans to make portions of its' acquisition accessible for individuals with disabilities. For Dennis Port residents and visitors living with limited mobility, an accessible trail will be a welcome opportunity to enjoy nature in a safe and user-friendly manner.

The Advisory Committee on Disabilities voted unanimously to endorse the efforts of the Dennis Conservation Land Trust to acquire the available property and we encourage others to support this important addition to our Town.
